

Research Misconduct, Plagiarism and Its Causes

Research misconduct – "fabrication, falsification, or **plagiarism** in proposing, performing, or reviewing research, or in reporting research results" (Awasthi, 2019; Roig, 2010)



Plagiarism - "copying (or using) of others' work that (accidently or otherwise) deceives a third party about the authorship (or ownership) of the work" (Yeo, 2007, p. 201).



Causes of Plagiarism (References: Jareb et al., 2018; Salleh, Starovoytova, 2017; Harji et al., 2017)


Institutional failure


